The Eastmain First Responders are a team or teams who provide a First Aid Service in our Community of Eastmain. Formally established in 1995, the First Responders are responsible for the implementation of 7 programs of the Public Health Services of the Cree Nation of Eastmain.

The Eastmain First Responders' department identifies and minimizes the risks of Community Public Health. These First Responder Teams respond to urgent or crisis situations, including suicide attempts, family violence and community disasters. Some teams also assist with search and rescue activities and they operate the Community First Aid Unit.
